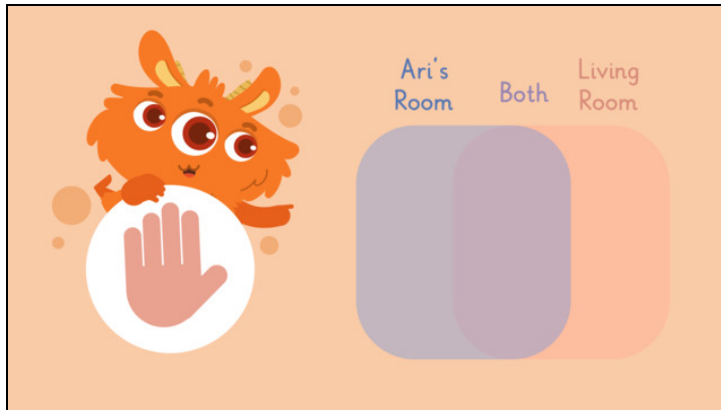

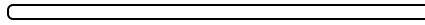

Consider the **characteristics** of each **setting**.

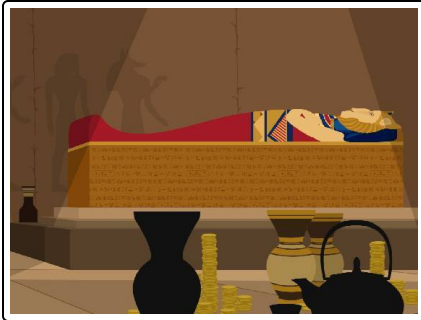
2. Hint
