
How many dinosaur bones did Mr. Squeaks see?


Add the blocks and place the totals correctly.

Our hints for the tasks



How many dinosaur bones did Mr. Squeaks see?

1. Hint

Remember to start by adding the **ones**, then move to the **tens**, and then the **hundreds**.

2. Hint

Remember to check how many of each place value there are **altogether**, and place this number at the bottom.




Solutions and solution approaches for the tasks



How many dinosaur bones did Mr. Squeaks see?

Answer key: 1: 1 // 2: 7 // 3: 5



Mr. Squeaks saw **175** bones!

- 2 ones plus 3 ones equals 5 ones
- 1 ten plus 6 tens equals 7 tens
- 1 hundred plus 0 hundred equals 1 hundred
- When we put these together, we get a total of 175
