




Greater than or less than?


Assign each number to greater than 35 or less than 35.



Skylar and Henry picked apples for many days. They need help deciding if the number of apples they picked each day is greater than or less than 35.










Our hints for the tasks




Greater than or less than?

1. Hint



When comparing numbers, we start by looking at the tens place. 35 has a 3 in the tens place. Is the number in the tens place greater than or less than 3?




Solutions and solution approaches for the tasks



Greater than or less than?

Answer key: A: 1, 2 // B: 3, 4



The number 35 has 3 tens and 5 ones. When comparing numbers, we start by looking at the tens place and seeing which one has more. Remember, we start with the tens place because it is the larger place value. When the numbers are the same in the tens place, then we need to look at the ones place to compare. 33: The number 33 is **less than** 35. It has 3 tens and 3 ones.

82: The number 82 is **greater than** 35. It has 8 tens and 2 ones. 15: The number 15 is **less than** 35. It has 1 ten and 5 ones.

60: The number 60 is greater than 35. It has 6 tens and 0 ones.
