

Place the correct numbers into the number sentence.




Mr. Squeaks has **eight** blueberries and Imani has brought **three** raspberries. How many berries do they have altogether?

### Our hints for the tasks



# How many berries do they have?

#### 1. Hint

How many blueberries did Mr. Squeaks have? This is your starting number. We are starting with this number because it is the *biggest* number.

#### 2. Hint

How many raspberries did Imani bring? This is the number you are adding on.

#### 3. Hint

Use the jumps on the number line to help you find the total number of berries.




### Solutions and solution approaches for the tasks



### How many berries do they have?

**Answer key:** 1: 8 // 2: 3 // 3: 11



They have **eleven** berries altogether.

- Mr. Squeaks had 8 blueberries.
- Imani brought 3 raspberries.
- Using a number line to help us, we start at **8** and count on **3** more.
- We end on **11**, so that is our answer.
- This problem could also be solved by starting at **3** and counting **8** jumps forwards.
- We would still land on **11** if we did it this way.
